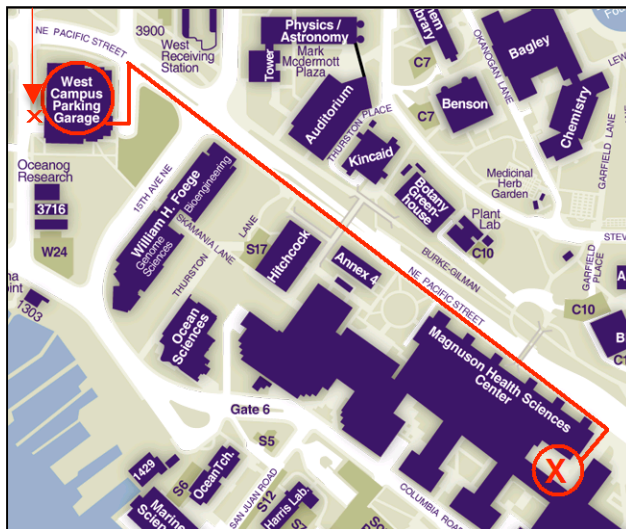


Parking - Directions
